WHEREAS, the Council, by Resolution No. 168-90, adopted a procedure on Requests to

Establish a Residential Parking Permit Program; which Procedure was subsequently amended by

Resolutions No. 450-91, 433-2006 and 489-2014; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of the Council to establish a Residential Parking Permit

Program for the 1200 block of Scoville Road.
