Authorization to accept the attached Agreement with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), Tactical Diversion Squad Task Force Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall be from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020. The <u>Tactical Diversion Squad Agreement</u> allows for one (1) Lexington Police Department Officer to be assigned to the Tactical Diversion Squad for a period of not less than two years. During this period of assignment, the officer will be under the direct supervision and control of a DEA Supervisory Special Agent assigned to the Tactical Diversion Squad.
