A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Office of Homeland Security, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$60,000 Federal funds, under the 2016 State Homeland Security Grant Program, are for the cost of the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Disablement Training Course materials, instructor and the purchase of training equipment kits for the Div. of Police, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Authorization to accept award of Federal funds in the amount of \$60,000 from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for the Improvised Explosive Devise (IED) Disablement Training Course and purchase of equipment kits for response and sustainment training for use by the Division of Police under the 2016 State Homeland Security Grant Program. Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the Kentucky Office of Homeland

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
