An Ordinance amending certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for funds in the amount of \$4,860 in the Div. of Traffic Engineering for pedestrian wayfinding wraps and appropriating and re-appropriating funds, Schedule No. 61. WHERAS, it is necessary and proper to amend the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for funds in the amount of \$4,860 in the Division of Traffic Engineering for pedestrian wayfinding wraps:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for funds in the amount of \$4,860 in the Division of Traffic Engineering for pedestrian wayfinding wraps and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed:

Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
