A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute and submit a Grant Application to the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), to provide any additional information requested in connection with this application, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$150,000 Federal funds, under the 2017 Homeless Management Information System Capacity Building Project, which are for increasing bed coverage, increasing data quality, and the overall improvement of the Local Homeless Management Information System. Authorization to submit the 2017 Homeless Management Information System Capacity Building Project (HMIS), as a Collaborative Applicant, to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requesting federal funding in an amount up to \$150,000 for improvement of the HMIS system including increasing bed coverage rates and increasing data quality.
