Dept. of Military Affairs, Div. of Emergency Management and to provide any additional information requested in connection with this Grant Application, and to accept this Grant if the application is approved, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$779,200 Federal funds, and are for the continuation of the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) for FY 2019, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. [Div. of Emergency Management/911, Dugger] Authorization to submit an application and accept award, if offered, to the Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management requesting Federal funds in the amount of \$779,200 under the Fiscal Year 2019 Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP). Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) for FY 2019, and the acceptance of which does not

obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.
