A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from LG&E and KU Energy LLC, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$3,500, are for a Tree Planting Project in Shillito Park, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$3,500 as a local match, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget established herein.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
