A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an Agreement with Brandstetter Carroll, Inc., for design services for renovation of Fire Station #9, at a cost not to exceed \$31,750. [Div. of Fire and Emergency Services, Chilton]

Authorization to execute an Agreement with Brandstetter Carroll, Inc. for the design services for the renovation of Fire Station #9. The first phase of this work was competitively bid under RFP #20-2019. \$43,000.00 was approved by Council to complete the Phase A programming and design on November 15, 2018 per Resolution 700-2018. The project Budget has now been established and additional funding has been secured. The remaining design fees for design, development, and construction documents have been calculated at an additional cost of \$31,750.00. The total Contract amount will then be \$74,750.00. GOVERNMENT:
