RESOLUTION NO. 015 - 2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE KENTUCKY ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT CABINET, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$164,664.46, FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT FUNDING PROGRAM FOR FAYETTE COUNTY FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024, THE ACCEPTANCE OF

WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENTS WITH THE KENTUCKY ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

CABINET RELATED TO THIS GRANT; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR

TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, be and

hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the Kentucky Energy and

Environment Cabinet, in the amount of \$164,664.46, for the continuation of the Litter

Abatement Grant Funding Program in Fayette County, the acceptance of which does not

obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the

Mayor or her designee, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute any

necessary agreements with the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet related to this

Grant.

Section 2 – That subject to the provisions of Section 7-48 of the Lexington-Fayette

Urban County Government Code of Ordinances, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her

discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the

unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another

operating or capital account appropriation within the grant budget established for this grant.

Section 3 – That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
