SUBJECT: Amendment to Existing Agreement & Sole Source Resolution – Communications  
Venture Corp. d/b/a INdigital

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Request:

A resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an amendment to an existing agreement (Res.#324-2018) with Communications Venture Corporation (d/b/a INdigital), which is Lexington's provider of text-to-911 and text-from-911 telephone capability. Also, Authorizing INdigital as a sole source provider of text-to-911 services for Lexington and agencies in its network.

Why are you requesting?

INdigital requested the attached amendment to memorialize that the monthly network charges outlined in the original agreement (i.e., \$246.14 per month/per participating county) will be divided between Lexington and the other four (4) participating dispatch centers in Lexington's Central Kentucky 911 Network. As other counties in Lexington's Central Kentucky 911 Network implement an integrated text-to-911 solution, the annual monthly network connection expense for Lexington will decrease. There is no change to the FY20 expense as a result of the amended agreement and the expense is fully funded.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?

Annual connectivity is \$29,863.92 and was budgeted in FY20.

Are the funds budgeted? Yes; 4204-505602-0001-72204.
