а	<u>134-16</u>	Authorization to enter into a rental agreement with Worldwide Equipment Leasing, Inc. for a Yard Tractor (Yard Dog) located at the Material Recovery Facility. Currently, there is no backup for the machinery utilized daily to move five or more trailers efficiently in the operations. The cost is \$2,000.00 annually. Funds are budgeted. b	<u>135-16</u>	Authorization to approve Sole Source Purchase Request for Machinex to purchase parts and services for equipment at the Material Recovery Facility (MRF). The Division of Police has prepared four applications for submission to the Governor's Highway Safety Program in the Department of Transportation Safety/Kentucky Transportation Cabinet requesting federal fundina the Lexington-Fayette continuation of Urban County Government's Traffic Safety Programs for FY2017. The federal funds originate from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Highway Safety Standards Branch. Total federal funding in the amount of \$216,520 is being requested for FY2017 for officer overtime, Medicare, unemployment, training and equipment. local match is required.
