Question: Is there a geotechnical report or something showing depth of rock? If no geotechnical report would it be possible to have a rock allowance set by the city to make all bids equal?

Question: Any special backfill around gas line?

Answer: Contractor to coordinate with Columbia Gas Construction. Backfill within 6" of gas line must be approved by Columbia Gas.
