SUBJECT: Neighborhood and Community Sustainability Grant Program

The Department of Environmental Quality has budgeted funds to establish the Neighborhood and Community Sustainability Grant program to encourage residents to work collaboratively and creatively to find ways to improve the environmental health of our neighborhoods.

The following award recommendations are submitted to the Urban County Council for the approval to fund the proposed projects under the program.

- Columbia Heights Neighborhood Association, \$2350 for Beautification and Litter Cleanup Project.
- Dove Creek Townhomes Owners Association, \$1655 for Beautification and Landscaping Project.
- Fairway Neighborhood Association, \$2500 for street tree planting.
- Faith Lutheran Church, \$1590 for a Rain Garden Project.
- First Alliance Church, \$1957 for creating an Amphitheater Project.
- Glendover Neighborhood Association, \$2497 for planting Street Trees.
- Golf Town Homes at Andover HOA, \$2400 for a tree removal and replacement project.
- Gratz Park Neighborhood Association, \$2500 for a Landscaping Project.
- Meadowthrope Neighborhood \$2000 for using recycled rock for wall extension project.
- New Beginning Church of God in Christ, \$2452 for a Community Garden.
- Pasadena Neighborhood Association, \$920 for Tree and Vegetation Restoration Project.
