Section 2 - That all of the existing Lexvan Vanpool Program funds as of the effective fund transfer date of the agreement, be and hereby are approved for transfer to The Transit Authority of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, from the relevant account(s) #4205-XXXXXXX-XXXXX, pursuant to the terms of the agreement.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
