**SUBJECT: REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT AWARD  
OF FEDERAL AND STATE FUNDS FROM THE KENTUCKY  
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY UNDER THE  
HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE  
VERSAILLES ROAD SHELTER**

On March 3, 2011 (Resolution No. 86-2011), Council approved the submission of an application prepared by the Division of Emergency Management/911 to the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency requesting federal funding from FEMA's (Federal Emergency Management Agency) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the following project:

**Tornado Safe Room at Versailles Road Complex.** These buildings are constructed of sheet metal on a concrete slab. Occupants cannot be protected in the event of a severe storm or tornado. Upon approval of federal funds, a pre-fabricated storm shelter will be purchased for installation on the property.

Total project cost is \$29,435. Federal award amount is \$22,076 (75%). The state agency will provide 12% or \$3,532. A local match of \$3,827 (13%) is required. Local match is budgeted in the Fiscal Year 2014 budget in account number 1101-505201-0001-78201.

Council authorization to accept award of federal and state funds is hereby requested.
