The purpose of this memorandum is to request authorization to enter into an Assistance Agreement by and between Kentucky Infrastructure Authority and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government. This agreement will allow the LFUCG to accept a low-interest (1.75%) loan through the Federally Assisted Wastewater Revolving Loan Fund Program, Fund A in the amount of \$31,801,000.00 related to the Town Branch Wet Weather Storage Tanks Project.

Application was made after receiving authorization from the Urban County Council via Resolution 548-2012.
