SUBJECT: Approval of ThermoFisher Scientific as a sole source provider contract for

equipment for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services

Request: Council authorization to approve ThermoFisher Scientific as a sole source provider contract for the purchase of TruDefender FTX Handheld FTIR Analyzer equipment for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services at a cost not to exceed \$38,850.

Purpose of Request: On November 21, 2019 (Resolution 666-2019), Council authorized to accept two grant awards from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security Grant Program in the amount of \$44,280.00. The Division of Fire and Emergency Services was awarded two grants to replace/purchase equipment for the Special Operations Team. The equipment is outlined below:

1. Infrared spectrometer for chmical detection: \$34,965

2. FL 360 search camera for structural collapse/confined space rescue: \$9,315

ThermoFisher Scientific has been determined to be the sole source vendor for TruDefender FTX equipment for the State of Kentucky.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? A total in FY2020 is 38,850. No cost are anticipated for future budget years.
