Per our phone conversation I am writing to request an extension for the use of the funds provided under a Neighborhood Action Match Grant which was awarded in September 2020 in the amount of \$6,317. In Spring 2022 our Landscape Committee submitted a written request for a one-year extension which was granted in May 2022.


Our FPHA committee then put together an application to the KY State Historic Marker which was reviewed in July-August 2022. Given the large number of applications backlogged during Covid-closure of State offices, our application was not accepted for the 2022 State Historic Marker Program.

However, we have been encouraged to reapply during the 2023 application process which we intend to follow-up with a new application.

Given that the primary portion of this grant is to be spent on a Historic Marker plus related landscape improvements following the Marker Plaque installation, we are again requesting an 12-month extension to May 31, 2024....to complete our project and submit our reimbursement requests.
