Charles Edwards, Attorney, Grade 117E, \$1,802.02 biweekly in the Department of Law, effective August 4, 2014.


Nicole Wright, Telecommunicator, Grade 111N, \$15.242 hourly in the Division of Police, effective June 23, 2014.
