## Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request amendment of Resolution 256-2020, increasing the easement acquisition budget for this project from \$31,200 to \$42,200. This \$11,000 increase is the result of a fair market appraisal report obtained during acquisition negotiations between LFUCG and Fayette County School District, the owners of 1901 Appomattox Road.

### Purpose of Request

Resolution 256-2020 provided funding for the purchase of temporary and permanent easements on twentyone (21) parcels impacted by the Wolf Run D/E Trunk Sewer Project. This recommended increase to Resolution 256-2020 is the result of further negotiations between the owners of 1901 Appomattox Road and LFUCG.
