**SUBJECT: Supplemental Agreement No. 1 for Todds Road Sidewalk Project —  
Construction Phase**

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**Request:** Council authorization to accept federal funds of \$208,000 for the construction phase of the Todds Road Sidewalk Project as funded under the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Office of Local Programs Transportation Alternatives Program.

**Purpose of the Request:** On April 27, 2019 (Resolution 218-2017), Council authorized acceptance of \$80,000 in federal funds for the design phase of the Todds Road Sidewalk Project.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has now awarded the LFUCG federal funds of \$208,000 from the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for the construction of approximately 1,600 feet of sidewalk along the north side of Todds Road between Catera Trace and Woodhill Drive. Local match in the amount of \$52,000 is required for a total project cost of \$260,000.

**The cost in this budget year and future budget years:** \$260,000 (\$208,000 federal funds and \$52,000 local match).

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget Amendments 10328 and 10329 are in process
