This memorandum is in regards to the purchase request of the Ops-Core Ballistic High Cut XP tactical helmet and the Up Armor helmet side covers for use by the Lexington Emergency Response Unit. These helmets and side covers will be utilized to protect the members of the Emergency Response Unit during their response to critical incidents, call outs, high risk search warrants as well as during our bimonthly training evolutions. Ops-Core is a sole source provider of the product described below.

Due to the age of our current "Second Chance" helmets being approximately 10 years old, exceeding most helmet manufactures ballistic protection warranties, the Emergency Response Unit began to research the purchase of new ballistic helmets. We started our research in January of this year having several products from several different manufacturers sent to our team for field performance tests and evaluation. After evaluating several different products it is our belief that the Ops-Core Ballistic High Cut XP helmet is a far more superior product and has several characteristics that are unique only to the Ops-Core helmet.

The Helmet has a total weight of 2.73 lbs leading to less physical stress on the operator's neck and shoulders thus reducing the chance of injury during lengthy call outs, critical incidents and training. The 2.73 lbs is a 20% total weight reduction from other standard helmets that we've evaluated. This reduced weight does not compromise the ballistic protection quality of the helmet.

The Ops-core helmet offers an inner helmet liner "Windy Strips" that are adjustable to the individual operator thus making the helmet far more superior when it comes to being affixed and secure to the operators head. The versatility of the Ops-core inner liner makes it easy to adjust to several different tactical headsets for radio communication. As the Division is transitioning to TAIT Communications as our new radio communication provider it will allow the Emergency Response Unit more flexibility as it relates to our future purchase of a quality headset.

The Ops-Core helmets gives the Emergency Response Unit several tactical options due to a unique rail mounting system allowing for quick transition from eye protection, mounted lights and or night vision goggles to name a few. These tactical options allow the Emergency Response Unit the ability of having the tactical advantage during management of critical incidents [and more importantly] play a crucial roll in keeping our team members safe during their response.

The Up Armor side covers can be affixed to each side of the helmet and are utilized to protect the ears, head and neck. The helmet covers offer the same quality ballistic protection as the Ops-Core helmet. These side covers will be utilized for added head/face protection during riot control situations, NCAA Basketball celebrations and normal call outs and narcotics warrants.

The Ops-Core helmet is a sole source provider to several United States Government Agencies as well as a product provider to several law enforcement entities throughout the United States. Currently Frankfort Police Department and Kentucky State Police Tactical Teams utilize these helmets during warrant and critical incident scenarios, both agencies have given the product outstanding reviews.

After a lengthy 11 month testing and evaluating process of several helmet options we've determined that the overall quality of the Ops-Core helmet in terms of the tactical options it provides to the operator, overall comfort and fit, injury/stress reduction and the ballistics protection it provides is the best helmet suited for the Emergency Response Unit's specific needs. The Ops-Core Ballistic High Cut XP helmet has met the rugged standards we are looking for in protecting our officers during their response to critical incidents.

The Other helmets that we evaluated are as follows

- Pro-tech Sprint Ballistic helmet. This helmets design cut was too high and caused to
 much loss of ballistic protection compared to the Ops-Core. It also didn't come
 standard with the Night Vision Goggle mount. It also did not have the Occ-dial head
 harness for making the helmet more secure. This helmet was heavier and provided less
 protection than the Ops-Core.
- Pro-tech Delta 4 LT helmet. This helmet didn't have the desired cut designed necessary to aid in future communication (headset) needs. It did not have the Occ-dial style head harness, the NVG rail system or the side rail system. It was also heavier than the Ops-Core helmet.
- **Pro-tech Delta 4 HC helmet.** This helmet did not come equipped with a Occ-dial head harness system nor did it come equipped with a side rail or NVG rail. It was also to heavy compared to the Ops-Core
- MSA TC2000 Ballistic helmet. This helmet did not come equipped with a Occ-dial head harness. It also was heavier than the Ops-Core, does not have the rail system and its design did not aid in future communications (headset) needs.
- Max Pro Gunfighter Cut helmet. This helmet does not have the Occ-dial head harness nor did it have the rail systems.

The total purchase price for thirty Ops-Cope Ballistic High Cut XP helmet will be \$24384.15. The total cost of the Up Armor ballistic side covers will be \$6506.25. The total purchase price for both items will be \$30,890.40.
