**SUBJECT: KYTC Agreement for Winchester Road Intersection Improvements at East
Seventh Street/Liberty Road**

Request:

Request Council authorization to execute Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for improvements to Winchester Road intersection at East Seventh/Liberty Road in the amount of \$9,600 for the Design and Right-of-Way phases under the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)

Purpose of Request:

On September 25, 2014 (Resolution 556-2014), Council approved submission of an application to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for improvements to the Winchester Road intersection with East Seventh Street and Liberty Road. This project includes improvements to the signalized intersections of both East Seventh Street and Liberty Road and will slightly modify the Liberty Road approach and provide a pedestrian bulb-out on the northeast and southeast corners, making these intersections into safer, more efficient, and more useful community assets for pedestrians, transit riders, and vehicles.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG funds for design and right-of-way in the amount of \$9,600. A match in the amount of \$2,400 is required. Once design is completed, an amendment will be offered, providing construction funds in the amount of \$214,000.

Cost in this Budget year and future budget years: Design Cost: \$10,000

Right-of-way: \$2,000

Construction cost in FY 2017 will be \$214,400 in federal funds and \$53,600 in local match

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendments #7090 and 7091 are pending.
