SUBJECT: Extension of Period of Performance for the 2021 State Homeland Security

Grant Award for the Division of Police Hazardous Device Unit

Request: Council authorization to execute agreement with the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security under the 2021 State Homeland Security Grant Program extending the period of performance through June 30, 2024, for the Lexington Police Department Hazardous Device Unit to utilize remaining grant funds for the purchase of batteries to operate a bomb disposal robot.

Purpose of Request: On April 8, 2021 (Resolution 175-2021), Council authorized an application to the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security requesting federal funds from the Fiscal Year 2021 Homeland Security Grant Program. On February 22, 2022 (Resolution 047-2022), Council authorized to accept award in the amount of \$212,900 from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security under the 2021 State Homeland Security Grant Program. The Kentucky Office of Homeland Security under the 2021 State Homeland Security Grant Program has offered the Lexington Police Department Hazardous Device Unit an extension to extend the period of performance to June 30, 2024. The Lexington Police Department Hazardous Device Unit will utilize remaining grant funds for the purchase of batteries to operate a bomb disposal robot.
