SUBJECT: Substance Abuse Program at the Division of Community Corrections

Request: Council authorization to accept award of state funds from the Kentucky Department of Corrections in the amount of \$262,800 for the operation of a 40-bed Substance Abuse Recovery Program at the Fayette County Detention Center for FY 2021 and FY 2022.

Purpose of Request: LFUCG has been offered state funding of \$262,800 from the Kentucky Department of Corrections/Adult Institutions Division of Substance Abuse for operation of a 40-bed Substance Abuse Recovery Program at the Fayette County Detention Center for FY20 and FY21. The contract awards \$131,400 to operate a 20-bed program for females for two years and \$131,400 to operate a 20-bed program for males for two years. Program guidelines require separate participant area, classroom and recreation time segregated from the general population and include cognitive behavioral counseling, 12-step intervention and relapse prevention. Facility must have licensed Substance Abuse Program clinical staff.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Available funds in Fiscal Year 2021 is \$131,400 and in Fiscal Year 2022 is \$131,400 and will be used to contract with a substance abuse programming provider. Future years funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

Are the funds budgeted? FY21 budget amendment is in process.
