SUBJECT: Canteen Agreement

Request:

A resolution authorizing the Mayor on behalf of the Urban County Government to sign a three year agreement with Compass Group, d/b/a Canteen, which provides unattended vending services at the Public Safety Operations Center (PSOC).

Why are you requesting?

Compass Group USA, Inc. by and through its Canteen Division supplies the LFUCG's Public Safety Operations Center at 115 Cisco Rd. location with unattended vending services. LFUCG has an existing agreement through Canteen for vending services at the PSOC and this agreement replaces the earlier agreement. Canteen is changing from traditional vending machine services to unattended vending services (i.e., merchandise is not secured and paid for on an honor system – photo attached). This system allows more items to be available to employees and for purchases to be made via cashless self-checkout kiosks or a mobile app. LFUCG is not responsible for unpaid merchandise. The new vending systems are in secure areas accessible only to personnel who work at the PSOC. The new agreement is required for this change in service and LFUCG is only responsible for reimbursing Canteen for part of the cost of the new kiosks if the agreement is cancelled by the government prior to the end of the three year term.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?
