3. Grantee will furnish to the Foundation any information concerning a change in the proposal or a change in grantee's tax-exempt status.
4. If grantee's exempt status changes or if funds are not used for the purposes described in your proposal, the American Water Charitable Foundation reserves the right to have all remaining grant funds immediately returned.
