**SUBJECT** Grant Application for Household Hazardous Waste Management Grant Program

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**Request:** Council authorization to submit an application, and accept award if offered, to the Department of Environmental Quality—Division of Waste Management in the amount of \$101,745 for the support of a one-day household hazardous waste recycling event for Fayette County, the acceptance of which obligates the government to provide match in the amount of \$25,436.25.

**Purpose of Request:** The Division of Waste Management has prepared an application for submission to the state agency requesting funds for support of a one-day county-wide household waste recycling event. Funds will be used to contract with a vendor for appropriate disposal of hazardous waste. The Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Grants Program was established in 2006 by Senate Bill 50. KRS 224.43-505 (2)(c) specifies the establishment of a Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste management grants program.

**Cost in this budget year and future budget years:**

State funds in the amount of \$101,745 will be budgeted in Fiscal Year 2020. A match of \$25,436.25 will be budgeted in the Urban Services Funds (Fund 1115). Total cost will be \$127,181.25. No expenses are anticipated for future budget years.

**Are funds budgeted?** Budget amendments for Fiscal Year 2020 are in process.
