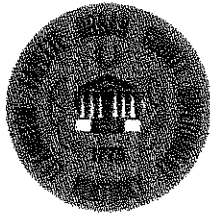


MOTION

SUBJECT: Southpoint Drive and Clearwater Way, No Through Truck Consideration.

Several weeks ago, the Division of Traffic Engineering was notified about the possibility of truck traffic utilizing Southpoint Drive and Clearwater Way to travel between Nicholasville Road and Tates Creek Road. When reviewing Southpoint Drive between Nicholasville Road and Clearwater Way as well as Clearwater Way between Man O' War Boulevard and Tates Creek Road, it was noted that there are two small properties which are zoned B-1 and two larger properties which are zoned A-U. Otherwise, the entire length of both roadways is bordered by residential properties. Lastly, larger vehicles needing to travel between Nicholasville Road and Tates Creek Road can utilize Man O' War Boulevard.

Conclusion: Based on the following: the majority of the properties along Southpoint Drive and Clearwater Way are residential, the few properties which are of business nature can be served regardless of the prohibition of trucks, and truck traffic can and should utilize Man O' War Boulevard when travelling easterly or westerly in this area, the Division of Traffic Engineering recommends the implementation of No Through Trucks along Southpoint Drive and Clearwater Way.
