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Administrative Synopsis - New Business Items

0723-15 Authorization to execute a "Sole Source" а agreement between Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government the BissNuss, Inc for the total price of \$25,216.00 purchase a 72" X 72" heavy duty sluice gate to replace a damaged gate at the primary effluent pump station located at the Town Branch WWTP. The fully budgeted (L0723-15) project is (Martin/Holmes)

Authorization to execute an agreement between the LFUCG and Level 3, as an addendum to contract 281-2014, Resolution 588-2014. The service order is for additional lines that will provide geographic redundancy and a solution to the failing phone system. The agreement will be for 36 months. The cost is \$28,878.24. Funds are budgeted. (L0730-15)(Nugent/Valicenti)

- Authorization to execute a Memorandum of Agreement between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government and LexArts for the maintenance of the Oliver Lewis Way Art Bridge. The artwork currently does not have a maintenance plan and the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet District 7 requires an agreement for project approval. The cost will be \$7,500 over the initial five (5) years. This money will be provided by LexArts. (L0751-15)(Houlihan/Emmons)
- 0753-15 Authorization to accept award of \$703,430.41 in FY 2016 funds from the Kentucky Commercial Mobile Radio Service Lexington Communications **911 PSAP** Emergency Board for Customer Premise Equipment Upgrade Project. This upgrade the technology that delivers calls to answering within the Enhanced 911 centers. This money will positions purchase new equipment that allows the LFUCG to maintain reliable 911 systems and allow Next Generation 911 features. The current system will reach end-of-life status in 2015. A amendment budaet is in process for FY16. (L0753-15) (Gooding/Bastin)
- e 0756-15 Authorization to accept a donation of one \$25 Kroger gift card from Joanna Rodes for client incentives for families served by the Family Care Center. There is no budgetary impact. (L0756-15)(Ford)

Authorization to accept award of \$200,000 in FY 2016 grant funds from the Environmental Protection Agency for Fayette County Courthouse Brownfields Cleanup Grant for Property.
