Dear Commissioner Squier,

The University of Kentucky is engaged in ongoing development of the UK Greek Park. In doing so, it is an opportune time for the university to address the closure of the unused alley between Rose Lane and Columbia Avenue (as shown on the attached exhibit). The closure would aide in consolidation of the university-owned parcels in this area. All of the adjacent properties are owned by the University of Kentucky with the exception of two parcels that are owned by Caney Creek Community Center Inc. We have contacted the owner and have received a favorable response to the closure.

We have had preliminary discussions with Chester Hicks of your office, Tom Martin of LFUCG Planning and District 3 Councilmember Jake Gibbs, and have provided the following documents for your review:
