Request:

Why are you requesting?

The Division of Parks and Recreation applied for funding from the Drug Free Lex Community Mini-Grant program. The program supports projects that address harm reduction and substance abuse. Drug Free Lex has offered LFUCG a grant in the amount of \$900. Funds will be used for the purchase of food and supplies for the "Teens Matter" summit to be held at the William Wells Brown Community Center. The purpose of the event is to address gun violence, bullying and substance abuse among teens in the East End.
