SUBJECT: Accept Award from FEMA for the Western Kentucky Tornado Expenses

Request: Council authorization to accept award of federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in the amount of \$107,184.03 from the Kentucky Emergency Management for reimbursement of expenses incurred from the Western Kentucky Tornado by the Division of Emergency Management and Fire and Emergency Services. No match is required.

Purpose of Request: Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government submitted application for reimbursement the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for reimbursement for expenses incurred from the Western Kentucky Tornado. FEMA Kentucky Emergency Management has awarded the Division of Emergency Management and Fire & Emergency Services a federal award in the amount of \$107,184.03 for Western Kentucky Tornado expenses.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Federal award is \$107,184.03. No match is required. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.
