SUBJECT: Kentucky-American Water Company Easement for Relocated Water Main
West Hickman Trunk D Remedial Measures Project

Request

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ) is recommending granting an easement to Kentucky-American Water Company (KAWC) for the relocation of an existing 8-inch water main at 3541 Greentree Road. This relocation is necessary for the construction of the West Hickman Trunk D sanitary sewer.

Purpose of Request

DWQ requested that KAWC relocate their existing water main so that DWQ's contractors could construct a boring pit for installation of the 48-inch sewer pipes that will cross both Armstrong Mill and Greentree. This boring pit is necessary to avoid long-term closure of those roads.

The parcel where the new easement would be located was purchased by LFUCG in 2003 as part of a multi-parcel flood mitigation project. DWQ has long recommended that no structures be built on that parcel, effectively reducing future use to perpetual passive use green space. Once granted, this easement will have no perceptible impact to continuing this use.

Project Cost in FY18 and in Future Budget Years

There is no project cost to LFUCG and no impact for future fiscal years.
