### **Description of Populus Mobility Manager:**

Enterprise license for Authorized Users for the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government ("the City" or "Customer") to access the Populus Mobility Manager analytics suite in Populus' proprietary web-based Terminal platform ("Terminal"). Populus Mobility Manager will deliver analytics to support monitoring and evaluation of mobility operators by the Customer, including the features outlined in the Terminal Services. Customer will provide data for or require that it be provided to Populus directly by the mobility operators.

#### Description of Customer Mobility Data to be Provided to Populus:

Customer will endeavor to provide the following Mobility Data to Populus for the purposes of utilizing the Populus Terminal for operator reporting compliance:

- (1) archival reports provided to the Customer by all permitted mobility operators that are required as part of an operating permit or voluntarily by the operators.
- (2) access to APIs provided to the Customer by all permitted mobility operators that are required as part of an operating permit or voluntarily by the operators.

#### Authorized Users

Lexington-Fayette County Parking Authority and University of Kentucky are considered authorized users under this agreement, provided that the policy regulating operators requires the ability to share data with third parties at the Customer's discretion.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 101 - 2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH POPULUS TECHNOLOGIES, INC., FOR DATA MANAGEMENT SERVICES RELATED TO DOCKLESS VEHICLES, FOR THE DIVISION OF PLANNING, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 – That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute a contract, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with Populus Technologies, Inc., for data management services related to dockless vehicles, for the Division of Planning, at a cost not to exceed \$10,000,00.

Section 2 – That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$10,000.00, be and hereby is approved for payment to Populus Technologies, Inc., from account #1141-160701-0001-72205 (subject to the approval of a pending Budget amendment), pursuant to the terms of the Contract.
