The grant application of <u>Bluegrass Greensource</u>, <u>Inc</u>. was reviewed and recommended by the Water Quality Fees Board at its <u>July 8, 2014</u> meeting. Funding is provided by revenue from the Water Quality Management Fee and is fully budgeted and available in the Fund:

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WQ GRANT

This grant requires a minimum 50% cost share by the grant recipient above the first \$2,500. The Grant Award Agreements require the Mayor's signature.

Grant Project Description

The objectives for this project include the development and roll out of five downloadable podcasts, a map, a tour, and a website to engage Lexington residents and visitors in water quality and ecological health issues. Possible podcast topics include: What's under there?; Karst Hydrology; We Are the Watershed; Streamside Living; and Keeping it clean. Another portion of the project includes leading public Water Walk events along the Town Branch Corridor.
