RE: DBE Forms and Submittals for EPA/KIA Funded Projects

You will have many projects with EPA/KIA funding that require special processes and paperwork especially for the EPA DBE Program. I would like to clarify what DBE paperwork should be included. I've had many conversations with our DBE representative in Atlanta, Charles Hayes.

The EPA 6100 forms have been revised and reinstated by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation Policy is not an EPA DBE form. It is a DOW form and should continue to be used and submitted with all bids.

Each engineer assigned to your projects should include the same forms in the same sections of the bid documents to eliminate any confusion to the bidders about the DBE requirements for these bids.

Engineers should remove the LFUCG MWDBE section and forms out of their bid documents. If for some reason a decision is made to keep them in the bid documents, please make it known to bidders at pre-bids and/or in addendums that only the EPA DBE documents should be submitted with the bid.

Fair Share Objectives:

Fair share objectives are negotiated at the state or regional level. The fair share objectives for Kentucky are broken into 4 categories and also separated into MBE and WBE percentages. I think this is very confusing. I've asked for a 10% DBE goal (combined or separate MBE/DBE/WBE) for our projects. Currently that is acceptable by the EPA DBE Coordinator.

The following forms should be included in the bid documents:

- 1) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation Policy
- 2) EPA Form 6100-2
- 3) EPA Form 6100-3
- 4) EPA Form 6100-4

The following forms should be submitted with the bid:

- 1) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation Policy
- 2) EPA Form 6100-3
- 3) EPA Form 6100-4

The following is required throughout the project:

- 1) Six good faith efforts should be used to secure any new DBE subcontractors or when substituting any DBE subcontractors.
- 2) The bidders list should be maintained throughout the entire project period.

Apparent Low Bidder—Contact the KIA Frankfort office for information on additional requirements and record keeping for the apparent low bidder.
