GRANT OF EASEMENT

<u>WITNESSETH:</u>

That for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 Cents (\$1,500.00), and other good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantor has BARGAINED and SOLD and does hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, the permanent right to lay, construct, operate. repair, reconstruct and remove a sanitary sewer line and appurtenances thereto, which sanitary sewer line and facilities shall be of such dimension, character, construction and use determined by Grantee along, through, under and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, and more particularly described as follows:

Permanent Easement (a portion of 216 St. Ann Drive) Idle Hour Sanitary Sewer Trunk Replacement Project

Beginning at a pinched pipe found along the southern right-of-way of St. Ann Drive, at the northeast corner of Lot 139, thence south along the eastern property line 213.32 feet to the Point of Beginning (POB 1), being an extension of a twenty foot wide permanent sanitary sewer easement; thence N 74°07'24" W a distance of

Being a portion of the same property conveyed to Lowell Foley and Aileen E. Foley, husband and wife, by Deed dated January 17, 1968, of record in Deed Book 922, Page 210, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office. Said Lowell Foley died testate a resident of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky on July 10, 1998, property vests to his wife, Aileen E. Foley, by right-of-survivorship.

FURTHER, for and in consideration of the foregoing sum, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor has BARGAINED and SOLD and does hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, the temporary right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of sanitary sewer construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located within the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, to wit:

Temporary Construction Easements (a portion of 216 St. Ann Drive) Idle Hour Sanitary Sewer Trunk Replacement Project

Being two construction easements for sanitary sewer improvements located at 216 St. Ann Drive and being more particularly described as follows:

Temporary Construction Easement - CE1

Beginning at a pinched pipe found along the southern right-of-way of St. Ann Drive, at the northeast corner of Lot 139; thence south along the eastern property line 185.92 feet; thence west along the northern line of the existing easement N 74°06'29" W a distance of 16.54 feet to the Point of Beginning (POB 2), being a temporary construction easement of varying width; thence N 74°06'29" W a distance of 16.98 feet to a point; thence N 04°42'24" W a distance

of 16.69 feet to a point; thence S 39°45'11" E a distance of 27.68 feet to a point; which is the point of beginning, having an area of 133 square feet, 0.003 acres; and,

Temporary Construction Easement – CE2

Beginning at a pinched pipe found along the southern right-of-way of St. Ann Drive, at the northeast corner of Lot 139; thence south along the eastern property line 213.32 feet to the Point of Beginning (POB 1), being a temporary construction easement of varying width; thence S 06°47'36" W a distance of 14.18 feet to a point; thence N 73°29'08" W a distance of 4.84 feet to a point; thence N 18°23'36" E a distance of 3.95 feet to a point; thence N 74°07'24" W a distance of 21.49 feet to a point; thence N 04°42'24" W a distance of 10.68 feet to a point; thence S 74°07'24"E a distance of 27.68 feet to a point; which is the point of beginning, having and area of 284 square feet, 0.007 acres; and,

Being a portion of the same property conveyed to Lowell Foley and Aileen E. Foley, husband and wife, by Deed dated January 17, 1968, of record in Deed Book 922, Page 210, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office. Said Lowell Foley died testate a resident of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky on July 10, 1998, property vests to his wife, Aileen E. Foley, by right-of-survivorship.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described easements together with all rights, privileges, appurtenances and improvements thereunto belonging unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, for the purposes and uses herein designated.

The above-described temporary construction easements will expire upon completion of the construction of the improvement project on the land adjacent to this easement, run with the land for the duration of the improvement project on the adjacent land and, are binding upon the heirs and assigns of the Grantor.

Grantor does hereby covenant to and with said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, that she is lawfully seized in fee simple of said property and has good right to sell and convey the easement herein, and that she will **WARRANT GENERALLY** said title.

Grantor shall have the full right to use the surface of the land lying over said permanent easement for any purpose desired, provided such use will not interfere with Grantee's free use of the easement herein granted and provided further that no building or structure shall be erected upon, across, over or through said permanent easement without the written consent of the Grantee.

The obtaining of this easement was authorized by Resolution No. 406-2014 passed by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council on July 8, 2014. Pursuant to KRS 382.135(2)(a), this public utility easement is exempt from the requirements related to certificate of consideration. This conveyance is exempt from real estate transfer tax pursuant to KRS 142.050.


