

Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Special Council Meeting

Lexington, Kentucky January 24, 2012

The Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, Kentucky convened in special session on January 24, 2011 at 6:00 P.M. Present were Vice-Mayor Linda Gorton in the chair presiding in the absence of Mayor Gray, and the following members of the Council: Council Members Henson, Kay, Lawless, Martin, Blues, Crosbie, Ellinger, Farmer and Ford. Absent were Council Members Lane, McChord, Myers, Stinnett, and Beard.

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An Ordinance changing the zone from a Single Family Residential (R-1D) zone to a Professional Office (P-1) zone for 0.99 net (1.19 gross) acres, with dimensional variances, for property located at 154, 158, and 162 N. Ashland Ave., subject to certain use restrictions imposed as conditions of granting the zone change (The Lexington Hearing & Speech Center, Inc.) was on the docket for second reading with a public hearing being held.

Mr. Martin stated that he had to recuse himself from the public hearing because of a conflict of interest.

Ms. Crosbie stated that she had to recuse herself from the public hearing because of a conflict of interest.

There being only 8 Council Members present after Mr. Martin and Ms. Crosbie recused themselves from the hearing, Ms. Gorton declared that the Council was in recess until 6:20 pm to determine if quorum requirements would be met (Pursuant to Section 4.102 of the Rules and Procedures of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council, a quorum of the Council shall not consist of fewer than ten members of the Council.).

At 6:20 p.m., Ms. Gorton stated that since there was no quorum, the Council meeting could not be held.

Ms. Lawless made a statement to those present for the meeting and apologized.

Ms. Gorton stated that the meeting was closed.
