SUBJECT: Agreement with Blue Grass Airport - 800 MHz Radio System

Request:

The Division of Enhanced 911 is requesting a resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with the Blue Grass Airport Board for use of the 800 MHz public safety radio communication system. Attached are three original agreements signed by Scott Lanter, Director of Public Safety and Operations, Bluegrass Airport. Please return one original to my attention.

Why are you requesting?

The agreement explains how the two entities will manage the system. It outlines in detail key matters of understanding including, but not limited to: equipment ownership, maintenance responsibility, use of shared resources, FCC licenses, billing, and how annual maintenance costs will be determined as the system expands. Annual maintenance cost for the Urban County Government and Bluegrass Airport are outlined in the original purchase agreement with Airbus DS Communications (f/d/b/a Cassidian Communications) in Resolutions 264-2012 and 0908-2015.
