SUBJECT: Request Council authorization to submit application to the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency requesting \$143,550 in federal and state funds from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for an emergency generator for the Family Care Center

The Division of Emergency Management/911 has prepared an application for submission to the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency requesting federal funding from FEMA's (Federal Emergency Management Agency) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the following project:

Generator for Family Care Center The Family Care Center has been designed as an overnight relocation site for day care children in the event of a disaster. There is no back-up power in this facility to continue operations should power be lost or interrupted. Total cost of generator is \$165,000.
