TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said easement unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, for the purposes and uses herein designated.

The above-described temporary construction easement runs with the land for the duration of the improvement project on this land and is binding upon the successors and assigns of the Grantor. The temporary construction easement shall take effect upon the commencement of construction of the project and will expire upon completion of the project.

Grantor does hereby release and relinquish unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, all of her right, title, and interest in and to the property, including all exemptions allowed by law, and do hereby covenant to and with the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, that she is lawfully seized in fee simple of said property and has good right to sell and convey the same as herein done, and that she will **WARRANT GENERALLY** said title.

The obtaining of this easement was authorized by Resolution 477-2016, passed by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council on July 5, 2016. Pursuant to KRS 382-135(2)(c), this temporary construction easement, which pertains to a public right-of-way, need not contain a statement of consideration.
