Request Approval of an Update of Area Designation for the Solid Waste Management Plan

for Lexington-Fayette County for 2023-2027, Pursuant to KRS 224.43-340 and 224.43-345

**Request:** The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of the Solid Waste Management Area Designation for 2023-2027, pursuant to KRS 224.43-340 and 224.43-345, as required by the Lexington-Fayette County Solid Waste Management five-year planning process.

**Authorization to:** Designate the Solid Waste Management Area for the next five years (2023-2027) as Lexington-Fayette County; the area includes no other cities or counties.

Why are you requesting? State law requires Lexington's Division of Waste Management to submit a five-year plan. The plan requires the designation of the Solid Waste Management Area. As part of the solid waste management planning process, the area must be officially designated. There is no change to the designation area from the last five-year period. The official designation area is Lexington-Fayette County and includes no other cities or counties.
