SUBJECT: Grant Application for the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project

Request: Council authorization to submit application and accept award, if offered, to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting federal funds in the amount of \$50,821 for the continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project for FY 2022. Match amount of \$12,913.87 is required.

Purpose of Request: The Division of Police has prepared a grant application for submission to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting federal funding for continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement project for Fiscal Year 2022. LFUCG is requesting federal funds in the amount of \$50,821 to continue the activities of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Division of Police. Match in the amount of \$12,913.87 is being requested in the FY22 General Fund for a total project cost of \$63,734.87. The source of these federal funds is the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program in the U.S. Department of Justice.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Cost in FY22 is \$63,734.87. Match in the amount of \$12,913.87 is being requested in the FY22 General Fund budget. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.
