**SUBJECT: Extension of the Period of Performance for the 2023 State Homeland Security
Grant Award for the Lexington Police Department Hazardous Devices Unit**

Request: Council authorization to execute an agreement with the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security under the 2023 State Homeland Security Grant Program extending the period of performance through August 31, 2026, for the Lexington Police Department Hazardous Devices Unit to utilize grant funds to purchase a bomb squad mission response vehicle.

Purpose of Request: On April 27, 2023 (Resolution 238-2023), Council authorized to execute an agreement and to submit an application and accept award if offered to the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security requesting federal funds from the Year 2023 Homeland Security Grant Program. The Lexington Police Department Hazardous Devices Unit was awarded \$454,000 to purchase a bomb squad mission response vehicle. Due to factory production delays the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security has offered the Lexington Police Department Hazardous Devices Unit an extension to the period of performance to August 31, 2026.
