SUBJECT: Authorization to execute Amendment No. 3 to Neighborhood Action Match Agreement with Hill-N-Dale Neighborhood Association providing for an extension through June 30, 2015

On November 18, 2010, the Urban County Council, per Resolution No. 630-2010, authorized the award of \$10,000.00 in Neighborhood Action Match Program funds to the Hill-N-Dale Neighborhood Association for the construction of a bus shelter on Southland Drive. The project was delayed to ensure proper placement and coordination with the Southland Drive bike lane project and other agencies.

On January 31, 2013 ((Resolution No. 25-2013), Council approved an extension of the completion date of this project through December 31, 2013

On December 10, 2013 (Resolution No. 692-2013), Council approved an extension of the completion date of this project through December 31, 2014.

The Hill-N-Dale Neighborhood Association has requested an extension through June 30, 2015. The bus shelter construction is partially supported with federal funds from Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, and obstacles with project approval from KYTC and need to re-bid the construction has delayed the project.
