Request: Council authorization to execute Purchase of Service Agreement with Special Electronic, Inc. in the amount of \$89,200.00 for the delivery of Intermediate and Advanced Electronic IED Disablement Training and related equipment for the Lexington Police Department and other Kentucky Public Safety Bomb Squads. Cost not to exceed \$89,200.00.

Purpose of Request: The Division of Police has been awarded a grant from Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for training for the functional capability of State and Local Bomb Technicians responding to IED incidents by enhancing knowledge of electronically initiated devices and detonator diagnostics per current FBI operational guidelines. RFP #15-2024 bid request for IED Disablement Training Special Electronics, Inc. Special Electronics, Inc. was chosen as the only vendor to provide Intermediate and Advanced Electronic IED Disablement Training and related equipment for the Lexington Police Department and other Kentucky Public Safety Bomb Squads.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$89,200.00 is cost in FY2024. No future cost anticipated.

Are the funds budgeted? Yes, \$81,000 from 3200-505505-5547-71299 STHO_BOMB2_2024 FED_GRANT and \$8,200.00 from 3200-505505-5547-75801-STHO_BOMB2_2024.
