### Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a Right of Entry agreement between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) and the The Reserve at Eden for the construction of a sanitary sewer line and appurtenances on LFUCG owned property located at 2019 Russell Cave Rd.

#### Purpose of Request

The Reserve at Eden is requesting Right of Entry to construct a sanitary sewer connecting a new development at 2020 Russell Cave Rd. to the existing LFUCG sanitary sewer system on 2019 Russell Cave Rd.

#### Project Cost in FY22 and in Future Budget Years

The Reserve at Eden has agreed to pay LFUCG six hundred fifty dollars and 00/100 (\$650.00) for the Right of Entry. No future costs are anticipated.
