

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY TO PROCURE RAILROAD CROSSING REHABILITATION SERVICES RELATED TO THE EXISTING GRADE CROSSING LOCATED AT THE TOWN BRANCH WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT, FROM R.J. CORMAN RAILROAD COMPANY, A SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENT WITH R.J. CORMAN RAILROAD COMPANY RELATED TO THE PROCUREMENT, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$40,193.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Division of Water Quality is authorized to procure railroad crossing rehabilitation services related to the existing grade crossing located at the Town Branch Waste Water Treatment Plant, from R.J. Corman Railroad Company, a sole source provider, and the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized to execute any necessary agreement with R.J. Corman Railroad Company related to the procurement.

Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$40,193.00, be and hereby is approved for payment to R.J. Corman Railroad Company, from account # 4003-303408-92811.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
