

RESOLUTION NO. 219 - 2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE KENTUCKY JUSTICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY CABINET AND TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THIS GRANT APPLICATION, AND TO ACCEPT THIS GRANT IF THE APPLICATION IS APPROVED, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00 FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE VICTIM ASSISTANCE FORMULA GRANT FUNDED BY THE VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA), FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UNDERSERVED MINORITY VICTIMS ADVOCACY PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH OBLIGATES THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO AN EXPENDITURE OF \$57,644.00 AS A LOCAL MATCH, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER ENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute and submit the Grant Application, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet and to provide any additional information requested in connection with this Grant Application, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$100,000.00 Federal funds under the Victim Assistance Formula Grant funded by the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA), for the implementation of the Underserved Minority Victims Advocacy Program in the Department of Social Services, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government to the expenditure of \$57,644.00 as a local match.

Section 2 – That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 97-21, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 -- That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
